

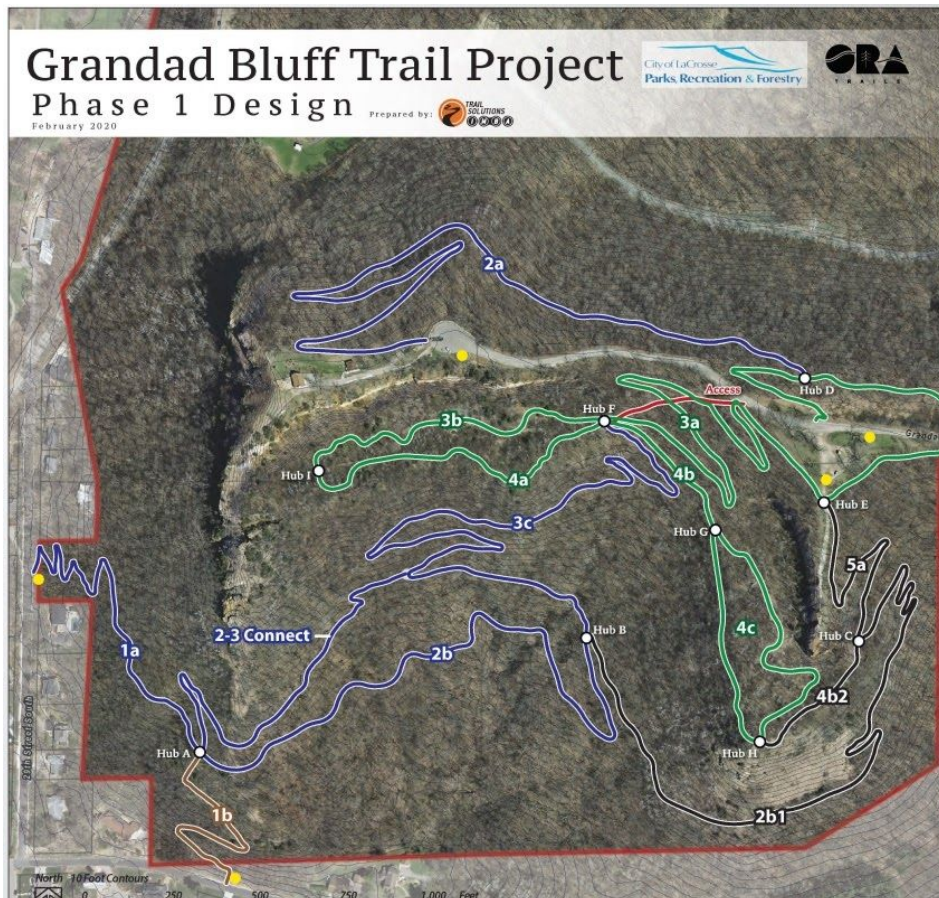
Grandad Bluff Park Trail Project

Signage Request

May 15th, 2020

As the City of La Crosse Parks, Recreation and Forestry Department and The Outdoor Recreation Alliance of the Seven Rivers Regions (ORA Trails) continue to collaborate on the development of the Grandad Bluff Park Trails & Recreations project, we would like to request permission to erect signs acknowledging the trail system and acknowledging it's partners.

Each sign would be constructed of sturdy, weather-resistant materials and fit with the atmosphere of the park and surrounding area. The proposed locations would be at the 29th Street Community Access Point, the Ebner Coulee Community Access Point, the Georgia's Point parking area access point, the Grandad Bluff Park Overlook parking area Access Point and along Grandad Bluff Road. The signs would identify significant partners in the project collaboration such as City of La Crosse Parks, Recreation & Forestry, ORA Trails and the financial donors, Warren & Denise Loveland Family Fund of the La Crosse Community Foundation. The signs will be accompanied by maps, user etiquette & guidelines and outdoor education items.
