TYPE OF ALTERATION: STOP control, requiring Liberty traffic to stop

GENERAL LOCATION: Intersection of Liberty Street & Charles Street

Report:

A request was received to investigate traffic control at the intersection of Liberty Street & Charles Street, which is currently Liberty traffic YIELD controlled.

To establish more proactive governance of right of way, the Board of Public Works could approve a STOP control. It would be recommended that the signs continue to be arranged for Liberty Street traffic to stop for Charles Street traffic.

**WHEREAS**, Section 44-39 of the City of La Crosse Municipal Code of Ordinances provides that after obtaining a report and recommendation of the Traffic Engineer, the Chief of Police shall forward recommendations and appropriate orders to the Board of Public Works.

**AND WHEREAS**, the Findings of the Traffic Engineer state the public interest, convenience, and necessity, the Chief of Police hereby Orders the above traffic alterations, to wit:

• STOP sign on Liberty Street, at the intersection of Charles Street.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of Public Works hereby approves the aforementioned traffic alteration, and City staff is hereby authorized to effect said changes.
