
Is housing discrimination keeping you out of a home?



HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION

It is unlawful for any person to be denied housing on the basis of sex, race, religion, color, national origin or ancestry, age, disability, marital status, lawful source of income, physical appearance, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, political activity, familial status or student status.

(City Ordinance Sec. 22-22)



La Crosse residents who believe they are the victim of housing discrimination may file a complaint with

You Have the Right:

- ♦ To pay for rent what was agreed upon in your lease. (WI Statute 704.19)
- ♦ To be returned your security deposit within 21 days from the move out date. (WI Statute 704.28) (WI ATCP 134.06)
- ◆ To live in a safe, code compliant building. do not be afraid to contact <u>Fire Prevention & Building Safety.</u> (WI Statute 704.07)
