WHEREAS, the Municipal Transit Utility is in need of purchasing and installing an Operator Germ Barrier in each of the buses in the existing fleet of buses; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Transit Utility has been granted the ability to transfer \$23,368.25 in 5307 MTU Operating Assistance Funds FY2020 to 5307 Emergency Relief Funds for the purchase and installation of COVID-19 related equipment for bus fleet vehicles.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse that it hereby authorizes the Director of Finance and the Municipal Transit Utility to purchase said support vehicles after a successful RFP for replacement vehicles has been performed. Operator Germ Barriers.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Transit Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the New Flyer Industries Parts and GILLIG Parts in connection with said Operator Germ Barrier System.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the cost and installation of the Operator Germ Barrier Systems from the quote received is \$23,368.25 and \$1,631.75 for contingency

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the sum of \$25,000 is hereby appropriated as follows:

\$25,000 - 5307 MTU Operating Assistance Funds FY2020

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Transit Manager and Director of Finance and Purchase, or his/her representative, are authorized to take any and all steps necessary to effectuate this resolution.
