


PFAS Water Testing La Crosse Regional Airport January 14, 2021

















Private Well Sampling (through January 8)

- In the Target Sampling Area
- 109 wells sampled at 106 properties (10/27/20 1/5/21)
- 14 samples still waiting for results from lab
- 55 samples were below DNR's proposed standards
- 40 samples were above DNR's proposed standards
- 20 properties with wells that have declined or not responded
- 23 properties w/o wells that have not responded









Bottled Water (as of 1/8/21)

Requested by and provided to 32 of 36 homes eligible 4 wells non-drinking water wells

4 homes have declined or not responded to bottled water offer
 Recommended for drinking, cooking, and brushing teeth
 Provided by Culligan of La Crosse


Bottled from a municipal water system

Filtered & treated

- Carbon filter, reverse osmosis, distillation & other methods

Sampled for PFAS

No PFAS was detected in the sample of Culligan Water



Next Steps

Resample 8 – 10 wells that were just below standards Letters to about 50 Residents in Expanded Sampling Areas Residents sign and send access agreements back to OS Group
