I would like to go on record as being strongly opposed to the proposed rezoning from R-5 to R-6. There are many reasons I am opposed to this zoning change and a few ideas on how we could remedy this situation. They are listed below.

- This change rezones the entire 4.5 acres parcel to R-6. This allows construction of buildings up to 10 stories on the entire property. All structures on the Eagle Crest property are currently 1 story with the exception of the chapel steeple.
- This is a very quiet residential area.
- There are HOWEVER, ways to allow this to happen without/ short of rezoning the entire parcel to R-6. Once this is done the genie is out of the bottle.
- Eagle Crest could request an (Area Variance) form the city. Current zoning allows them to build up to 3.5 stories. The proposed building is only 4 stories. This requires a variance of only 7 feet. This is their figure. An (Area Variance) specifically mentions minor exceptions for setback and Height. This is only a 7-foot difference, which is very minor.
- This variance would achieve Eagle Crest goals of allowing each resident to have private rooms. It also allows the current residents of Green Island the comfort of knowing that we will not have uncontrolled high-rise development in this neighborhood.
- It is a win / win solution.
- If this compromise cannot be achieved, I would ask that you deny this request, so that we can preserve the natural and quality of our island neighborhood. This rezoning is not compatible with the city's own comprehensive plan.
