- 3 **Discuss Riverside North Sculpture Project Solicitation, Timeline, and Funding - Terpstra**

Terpstra was excused, but e-mailed a Brushwork proposal, likely be for next year; Board emphasized importance of incorporating local artists (Brushwork would require local assistants) and be clear about funding; idea could be expanded to a sculpture park along trail, music & lighting, and chalk art on Patros foundation.

- 4 **Discuss Art Proposal for ReNEW La Crosse (05/20-06/24 in LN-D) - Weidenbach**

Banners were the first proposal; Metre did La Crosse Reads for \$900 + design - \$30-40/banner or more for other banner styles; request City hang banners without charge (unlikely); use local printers, but consider lifespan (color fading). Fence art by Shuh Homes was the second proposal; examples at Powell Park and other locations.

Parker made a motion, Krump seconded, directing staff to request Capital Improvement Program funding for public art maintenance, art for the La Crosse Center, and neighborhood murals. The motion carried by voice vote.
