Discussed possible cheap, raw building for makerspace, like Buzz's Bikes, Grand River Station, La Crosse Plow Building. Grand River Station's public workshop space and gallery are not very accessible; suggest one point person for both. 2nd floor below The Warehouse may have possible studio space; Steve Harm could set up tour. Coulee Region Business Incubator could also incorporate maker space and partner with other space for retail or gallery space.
