<u>17-0369</u>	La Crosse Sign Group Street Privilege Permit request for one double-sided, 7' high x 3' wide, non-lit sign to overhang sidewalk at 502 Main Street for Interact.

<u>17-0365</u>	Reconsider the sanitary sewer and water assessments for the sewer and water on St Andrew from Sumner St to Copeland Ave.
