Council member Weaver asked of initial application/complaints can be shared with rest of committee. Fredrickson stated clerk will distribute to all. Paul cautioned for walking guoroms. Julia asked asked about the hearing examiner - of it is the choice of the HRC & what the cost would be. Paul stated yes - HRC's choice, usually an attorney. Julia also asked about section J relating to the Housing Authority & Madison's systems - HRC only handles things not handled by HUD but rather City Ordinance. Paul noted two to a repeal and replace ordinance. Council member Marcou also abstract of the Chair vetting process was a Madison recommendation. Paul noted no. Council member Marcou did not like two options. Xiong asked of certain complaints & if we can have a lot of appropriate resources that pair with types of complaints. Weaver asked Paul if there are any solutions.

Paul noted no good solutions due to 1st & 2nd amendment; issues Julia noted making about one committee Nese noted you could increase police presence to make sure people feel safe. Also suggested when symbols of hate and weapons present, the cites policy be to measure serenity in the public.
