The software will revamp residential permitting - next step is updating the parking ordinances. Ordinance in force April 15 (For citations over 60 days past due). Long term - better uniformity (all 2 hour now; no 60/90 min); downtown mapping & facilities need priorities. Mobile pay zone pilot around campuses (1 year pilot.)

Jennifer will do talking to market to NA's council meeting (shoot for November) Mayor - What else do we need on parking (work on ending legislation for parking benefit districts)

Janssen - Mobile pay is a great start - NRC help fine tune it (perhaps support it going further out)

Trost - NRC will work aggressively on benefit districts.

Kabat - Ask Jim to bring updated parking inventory/usage data.
