Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 6 P.M.

Marcus Zettler recused himself from the committee and sat in the audience.

Agenda Items:

1. [18-1582](#) Application of the Boathouse identified as Pettibone River Front #006 (401 Pettibone Dr S H-6) to be designated as a local historic landmark.

Joe wrote a letter to the comission requesting his boathouse be identified as a historical landmark. Terence Collins asked for a photo of the boathouse. David asked for information on the boathouse. Joe noted there was not good records in the past, but was in contact with the Wisconsin DNR and spent time looking for more records. Joe was asked to email a photo to staff of the existing boathouse for record. Chris Kahlow moved to designate the boathouse under the exisiting nomination and criteria. Daniel Manke seconded. The motion was approved 5-0.
2. [18-1586](#) Review of plans for the exterior renovation/restoration of 201-215 3rd Street N. (Commercial Design Review Requirement)

Terence Collins asked if the Commission was reviewing the interior. Staff stated that they were not. Chris Kahlow asks what authority does the Heritage Preservation Commission have in this aspect. Staff stated that any project that has to go through the City's design review process that is adjacent to a historically designated structure must also go before the Heritage Preservation Commission. While there is no criteria that is set for this review process staff will be reviewing them to the same standard as if a local designated structure was being reviewed. Marcus Zettler provided an overview of the plans. After answering the commissions questions, Marcus left the room for the commission to make its final decision. A motion to approve was made by Terence Collins and seconded by David Riel. The motion passed 5-0.
