USACE staff went through presentation. Study focuses on what else can be done besides levies and flood walls. They presented on this initial part of the study and will get funding for future steps. The study included 16 residential and 4 commercial buildings. They have seen the SEH study so far; that study may not remove all structures, so non-structural interventions can be implemented. FEMA representative has come to speak to committee; FEMA is shifting to more money up front for mitigation. This study can help communities that haven't had flood damage.
