Center; Artspire is looking for volunteers, and public art project award announcement is Saturday; La Crosse Center Art subcommittee had two meetings about developing a request for proposals or expressions of interest; the sticks sculpture proposal did not get a mini-grant; Moses is working on Art Stops downtown and banner program; Weidenbach and McKnight volunteered for banner subcommittee.

#### **Agenda Items:**

1 19-0826 Discuss Lyra Relocation - Parks, Recreation, & Forestry Department

Jay Odegaard shared the downtown neighborhood association's request to move Lyra in order to make more useable space in Burns Park and requested Arts Board's input. Sculpture was placed in park in 1991 and about 10 years ago Council directed sculpture's original color be restored. Odegaard proposed location at La Crosse Marina to serve as a landmark for boaters since Lyra is also constellation of stars which have been used for navigation. Moses requested clarification from staff on process for moving sculptures, and neighborhood association share vision for park renovation with Arts Board.

2 19-0845 Discuss Potential Mural for 2019

Williams mentioned consideration of parking ramp stairwells for student art, and Bimbo Baker wall facing Cameron Park. Moses is working with artist on Art Stops that could do murals. Weidenbach will look at operating budget and requested Moses invite artists and update list of potential sites. Luke Achterberg suggested avoiding southern facing walls and working with sign companies to donate paint overage.
