<u>19-0523</u> Presentation: Mosaic Community Planning - Affirmative Furthering Fair

Housing

Jeremy Gray from Mosaic Community Planning presented a draft analysis of

impediments overview report for the fair housing study that was completed for the Housing Authority, City of La Crosse, La Crosse County, as well as four other surrounding Housing Authorities. Gray touched on the eight impediments that have been identified based on the data and public input collected. Currently the analysis is in the 45-day public comment period where feeedback was generated from today's presentation.

<u>19-0524</u> Approve Division Street 4-Plex and Duplex Bid.

The Division Street four-plex and duplex bids were reviewed.

Motion by Cable, second by Sayner to accept the base bid of \$1,097,600.00 and alternate number one with a deduction of \$7,500.00 received from Olympic Builders, Inc. totalling \$1,090,100.00. Motion carried.
