*Jacob Sciammas of the La Crosse Neighbors Inc. spoke regarding Bike Share in La Crosse. Mr. Sciammas read a letter (see attached) from Dr. John Cochran from Logistics Health Incorporated (LHI) stating "An investment in our biking infrastructure represents an investment in keeping our businesses thriving and our visitors returning to a vibrant and beautiful area. Please consider making every effort to support biking infrastructure in La Crosse for our businesses, visitors, students and children." "Bike Share has a goal of having 10 stations in La Crosse."*

*The Community Bike Share Group requests of the Bicycle Pedestrian Advisory Committee to review a proposed bike share station map (see attached link) and consider using BPAC funds for:*

- 1. Bike Share station(s) sponsorship and/or co-sponsorship (each stations costs \$10,000 per year/per station) with a 3 year commitment with revenue sharing on ridership that would return to the Bike Share System for reinvestment/growth.*
- 2. BPAC Master Plan priority infrastructure improvements that coincide with preferred routes between stations to encourage private and non-profit investment*

*BPAC requested that staff research how bike share sponsorship could be structured.*
