The program's vision is International mindedness through inquiry. They hope the program will expand to other schools in the district. Internationally, all IB schools have the same units of inquiry. Sister City and school reports/announcements: La Crosse School District, UW-L, Viterbo, Western, Luoyang, Kumbo, Friedberg, Forde, Epinal, Dubna, Bantry.

UWL – UWL has begun offering International Lunches that highlight international students on campus. The next one is February 11, 11:30 a.m. – 1 p.m. and the cost is \$8.75. April 18, 2020 is the annual International Banquet. In late Feb they'll be hosting a group of Japanese college students. They are looking for host families to begin Feb 27 for 9 days.

Viterbo – International student enrollment this semester includes 7 new students: 1 grad and 6 undergrads. Search is still underway for Director of International and Intercultural student success.

Luoyang – We are at the beginning stages of the Corona virus and one student was ill and had been diagnosed with Influenza A and is now feeling better. They managed to find hosts for all of the current group after a last-minute cancellation. The Chinese New Year Celebration was Saturday at All Star Lanes.

Friedberg – They are having Schnitzelfest at the American Legion in La Crosse, March 26, 5-8 p.m., cost is \$20.
