Special attention was given in the presentation to intersection accommodations for people with visual and mobility impairments. The following comments were offered from the committee: Street furniture next to the curb limits accessibility of van off-loading onto the sidewalk Maintain a clear zone that remains free of obstacles, bike racks, poles, planters. Consider moving sidewalk bike racks onto streets as the dimensions are ever changing based upon the orientation of bikes parked in them this presents a challenge to the visually impaired using "cane travel".
