

Historic Preservation Commission
Determination of Exception to 17' Height Limitation
Section 115-390

The applicant/owner, Greg Grob having requested an exception to the seventeen (17) foot height restriction of an accessory building/structure at 1024 Cass Street, and said request for such exception having been noticed and placed on the agenda of the Historic Preservation Commission this 22nd day of April, 2021, and the Commission having considered said request, finds:

The above-mentioned primary structure (is) or (is not) historically significant because:

- The primary structure is potentially eligible, eligible, or listed on the National Register of Historic Places, listed on the State Register of Historic Places, or locally designated by the City of La Crosse Historic Preservation Commission, or
- The primary structure is located west of Losey Boulevard to the Mississippi River and north of Green Bay Street to the La Crosse River Marsh on the south side of the City, or
- The primary structure was constructed prior to 1930.

The proposed accessory structure (is) or (is not) in keeping with the historic nature of the primary structure and surrounding properties.
