## CITY OF LA CROSSE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS Findings & Orders:

TYPE OF ALTERATION: Removal of Loading Zone

GENERAL LOCATION: East side of 24<sup>th</sup> Street South from a point 130 feet north of the north line of Cass Street and extending 45 feet northerly thereof.

## Report:

An application was received to investigate the 200 block of 24<sup>th</sup> Street south to remove the Loading zone on the East side of the block. At the time of the installation of the Loading Zone in 2005, the parcel was used for Elder Care and required additional Loading Zone for patient pick up and drop off. The current parcel owner (VSC) is requesting the removal of the Loading Zone.

It is therefore recommended to remove the Loading Zone in the 200 block of 24<sup>th</sup> Street S on the east side of the block.

**WHEREAS**, Section 44-39 of the City of La Crosse Municipal Code of Ordinances provides that after obtaining a report and recommendation of the Traffic Engineer, the Chief of Police shall forward recommendations and appropriate orders to the Board of Public Works.

**AND WHEREAS**, the Findings of the Traffic Engineer state the public interest, convenience, and necessity, the Chief of Police hereby Orders the above traffic alterations, to wit:

• Vacating Loading Zone in the 200 block of 24<sup>th</sup> Street South, as defined above.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of Public Works hereby approves the aforementioned traffic alteration, and City staff is hereby authorized to effect said changes.
