Proposed Business

LAX food hall gives an opportunity to community members blocked by existing racial and economic structures from starting their own restaurant business. It's a communal dining area with 10 stalls for 10 locally-owned restaurants, much like a food court, but with local food representative of each culture that makes up La Crosse. We especially look forward to assisting individuals of minority status or members of other disadvantaged groups open their own businesses. By removing most of the overhead, we change the capital needed to start a restaurant from \$350k to \$15k on average. Our goal is to create a community centerpiece for all of La Crosse's residents plus those visiting our city. Our strategic location on 5th avenue and Jay Street is perfect for this, surrounded by offices and right in the soon to be revitalized 5th avenue district. We are also a couple blocks from the existing entertainment district and a couple blocks from the newly remodeled convention center. We are the bridge from (and work in partnership with) the existing business incubator to restaurants getting their own storefronts. We also give owners of food trucks the opportunity to take that next step to brick-and-mortar restaurant ownership.
