TYPE OF ALTERATION: Reserved Parking – ADA zone			
GENERAL LOCATION: North side of 400 block of Jay Street, from a point 145 feet east of the east line of 4 <sup>th</sup> Street S, to a point 20 feet easterly thereof.			
Report:			
A request and application have been received from a caregiver regarding the feasibility of establishing an ADA parking space on Jay Street. This parking space will replace the current 2-Hour parking zone. The parking space is adjacent to a midblock crosswalk. It is recommended to establish the ADA parking zone as defined above.
