BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The subject ordinance would annex Tax Parcel 4-602-0 from the Town of Campbell. This parcel is not currently developed and is depicted on attached **MAP PC2014-03-03-07**. The applicant owns four contiguous parcels (one in the City of La Crosse) that are currently undevelopable due to floodplain zoning restrictions. The applicant would like to combine all four parcels so that future development may take place. This parcel is currently served by City water. A copy of the petition is attached.

GENERAL LOCATION:

At the south end of Kiowa Place, off of Nakomis Avenue.

➤ CONSISTENCY WITH ADOPTED COMPREHENSIVE PLAN:
