AN ORDINANCE to amend Sub-section 115-110 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse transferring certain property from the Local Business District to the Light Industrial District allowing combining of lots with adjacent parcel and business expansion at 812 and 814 Copeland Avenue.
