Institutional signs shall not exceed 32 square feet in area in residential zoning districts. Freestanding Monument institutional signs shall be subject to a maximum height of 3½ 7 feet in residential zones, Institutional signs in nonresidential zoning districts shall be subject to the regulations that apply to other ground monument or wall signs in public or semi-public zoning. A campus/medical/aggregate business (five or more businesses within a single building/property) and wayfinding monument sign shall not exceed 18 feet in height nor have a maximum face size of 150 square feet with no allowance for EMU/digital signs. A campus or medical wayfinding monument sign is specifically reserved for a major medical institution or hospital and a campus is de-
