ORDINANCE NO.: 5218

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 2-636 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse regarding membership of the International Committee. THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of La Crosse do ordain as follows: SECTION I: Section 2-636(a) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of

La Crosse is hereby amended to read as follows:

(a) Committee members shall be appointed by the Mayor for a term of three years and shall consist of no more than 42 13 members: One Council Member and 41 12 members to include representatives from the sister city committees, and the remainder a balanced representation from La Crosse educational and business institutions and area citizens with an interest in global connections. Appointment to the Committee shall be upon recommendation of the Committee and approval of the Common Council. Notwithstanding the residency requirements of section 2-422, members of the International Committee need not be residents of the City of La Crosse. No salary or compensation shall be paid to any member of said Committee for services.

SECTION II: Should any portion of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this division shall not be affected.

SECTION III: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
