TO CREATE AND EXPAND POLLINATOR-FRIENDLY HABITAT ON PUBLIC AND PRIVATE LAND.

The formative period for establishment of pollinator, occurs in late spring and early summer when they emerge from dormancy and require flowering plants as crucial foraging habitat; and these opportunities are dramatically reduced with early spring grass-mowing

How to Participate?

- 1.) Register your yard for "No Mow May" on the City of La Crosse Sustainability page.
- 2.) Pick up your yard sign at City Hall.
- 3.) Let your grass grow until May 31st!
- 4.) After May 31st, you must mow within two weeks to be in compliance with City ordinance.
