


to it in hand paid by the said part y of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged, has and given, granted, bargained, sold, remised, released and quit-claimed, and by these presents do as give, grant, bargain, sell, remise, release and quit-claim unto the said part y of the second part, and to its successors him and assigns forever, the following described real estate, situated in the County of La Crosse, State of Wisconsin, to-wit:

All that part of the former right of way of the Green Bay and Western Railroad Company in the West Half of the West Half (W $\frac{1}{2}$ -W $\frac{1}{2}$) of sections sixteen (16) and Twenty-one (21), Township sixteen (16) North, Range seven (7) West of the Fourth (4th) Principal Meridian, heretofore on January 17, 1938, conveyed by quitclaim deed, along with other property, by said Green Bay and Western Railroad Company to the Grantor herein, said deed being filed in La Crosse County, Wisconsin, in Book 183 of Deeds on page 454, expressly reserving to the Grantor herein, its successors and assigns, a perpetual right and easement to keep, maintain, and operate an electric power line or lines upon, over, and across the above described land, with the right to enter upon said land for the purpose of properly keeping, maintaining, and operating said transmission line. It is agreed and understood that the present location of the Mississippi Valley Public Service Company transmission line as now installed and operated on the above described land is the transmission line location reserved in this easement. It is further agreed and understood that the Mississippi Valley Public Service Company may relocate its present poles, towers, and fixtures or add additional poles, towers, and fixtures in the line to meet future operating conditions or needs of the power company and that the Chicago, Burlington & Quincy Railroad Company, its successors and assigns, will maintain statutory clearances between its tracks and the poles, towers and fixtures of said transmission line.
