

AN ORDINANCE to amend Sub-section 115-110 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse transferring certain property from the Low Density Multiple District to the Planned Development District allowing for owner-occupied twindos at 1002 5th Ave. S.
Proposed rezoning is necessary because: The proposed zoning classification allows for a twindo to be constructed under the exemption in multi-family development guidelines for zero lot line twindos.


