The overall average compliance rate decreased from nearly 89% in 2013 to 85% in 2014.





There was a net gain of 9 residential buildings for 2014. [30 new - 21 razed = 9] There was a net gain of 27 dwelling units for 2014. [61 new - 34 razed = 27]

There was a net *gain* of 9 garage/utility buildings built in 2014: 52 new detached garages and 19 new yard sheds. [52 + 19 = 71] [71 new - 60 razed = 9]

There were 7 new commercial and industrial structures built in 2014:
