RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, there is currently no funding for the investigation of complaints filed with the Human Rights Commission or the Ethics Committee, and


WHEREAS, it is necessary to obtain an independent investigator to assist in the investigation of complaints filed with both committees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse that it hereby authorizes the establishment of a committed special revenue fund for the sole purpose for use by the Human Rights Commission and the Ethics Committee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that \$25,000 be appropriated from the reserve fund and placed in said fund.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Finance Department is hereby authorized to take any and all steps necessary to effectuate this resolution.
