ORDINANCE NO. 4865
AN AMENDED ORDINANCE to amend Secs. 10-394 and 10-396 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse relating to Outdoor Food Stand/Mobile Food Unit adding an exemption for youth residents operating an occasional beverage stand and modifying location restrictions.
THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of La Crosse does ordain as follows:
SECTION I: Section 10-394 is hereby amended adding paragraph (9) as follows:
Sec. 10-394. - Exemptions.
(9) A city resident under the age of 18 selling water, soda, shaved ice or similar beverage only at occasional times from a stand on private property, or within a park with the permission of the Board of Park Commissioners, so long as said person is licensed with notifies the La Crosse County Health Department.
SECTION II: Section 10-396 is hereby amended as follows:
Sec. 10-396. - Location restrictions.
Licensed food stands or food units shall not operate upon or in any alley, sidewalk, street, public grounds or land dedicated to public use or in any part thereof.
Licensed mobile food units shall not operate upon or in any alley, public grounds or land dedicated to public use or in any part thereof. Where mobile units are being operated in any street, all traffic and parking regulations shall be observed and no unit shall impede the free use of such street. No licensed mobile unit shall be upon any street used as a parade route between the time one-half (1/2) hour immediately preceding the commencement of any scheduled parade until after the conclusion of any scheduled parade. Where mobile food units are being operated on any sidewalk, no unit shall impede the free use of such sidewalk and shall not have any exclusive right to any stationary location thereon.
No person shall operate an outdoor food stand or mobile food unit on property within a public park of the City unless authorized to do so by the Board of Park Commissioners. No person shall operate an outdoor food stand or mobile food unit or within 500 feet of any public park in which there is present a holder of a food-vendor's license from concession agreement approved by the Board of Park Commissioners of the City or a concession agreement with the City or where the City operates a food stand or mobile food concession.
SECTION III: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
