WHEREAS, the Mississippi River Cities and Towns Initiative (MRCTI) includes 120 plus river communities from the headwaters to the gulf coast; and

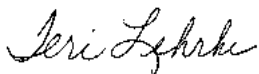

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Common Council of the City of La Crosse hereby appropriates \$3,500 from Contingency funds for 2017-2018 membership dues to the Mississippi River Cities and Towns Initiative.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in the future the annual membership dues will be proposed as part of the annual operating budget.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Common Council directs the Finance Department and Mayor to take the actions necessary to effectuate this Resolution.
