2623 An appeal regarding the requirement that fill around the perimeter of a building shall not be less than one foot below the flood protection elevation and shall extend at least 15 feet beyond the limits of any structure at 710 George St., La Crosse, Wisconsin.

2624 An appeal regarding the regulation limiting a residential accessory structure to a maximum of 35 percent of the rear yard square footage at 727 22nd St. N., La Crosse, Wisconsin.

2625 An appeal regarding the requirement to provide a rear yard setback of 20 feet at 411 3rd St. S., La Crosse, Wisconsin.

2626 An appeal regarding the requirement to provide a 25 foot setback from the front property line at 1647 Charles St., La Crosse, Wisconsin.

Property owners affected by an appeal may appear either in person, by agent, or by attorney, and may express their written approval of or objection to the granting of the appeal by filing a letter in the office of the City Clerk, or in lieu thereof may, upon oath, testify thereto.
