ORDINANCE NO.: 4976
AN AMENDED ORDINANCE to amend Subsection 115-110 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse transferring certain property from the Single Family District to the Public/Semi-Public District allowing the combining of parcels and construction of a storage building at 1710 Losey Blvd., 2300 Green Bay St. and 2310 Green Bay St.

THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of La Crosse do ordain as follows:

SECTION I: Subsection 115-110 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse is hereby amended by transferring certain property from the Single Family District to the Public/Semi-Public District on the Master Zoning Map, to-wit:

1710 Losey Blvd. (17-50091-50) - VERCHOTAS ADDITION LOT 3 BLOCK 3 (FIRE STATION).

2300 Green Bay St. (17-50091-30) - VERCHOTAS ADDITION LOT 1 BLOCK 3 EX NAVY RESERVE ADDITION.

2310 Green Bay St. (17-50091-40) - VERCHOTAS ADDITION LOT 2 BLOCK 3.

SECTION II: This ordinance is contingent upon screening the parking lot and storage facility from the memorial no later than the completion of the first phase of the Naval Reserve Site build out.

SECTION III: Should any portion of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this division shall not be affected.

SECTION IV: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
