THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of La Crosse do ordain as fol-

SECTION I: Paragraph 20.25(H) (11)(b)(iv) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse is hereby amended as follows:

(iv) All existing off-premise advertising signs that are within a 350 foot ra-dius from the public right-of-way of dius from the public right-of-way of designated Scenic Cornidors, and the City Vision 2020 Historic Central Business District, which are not located on the Federal Aid Primary System routes, National Highway System routes or Interstate 90, consisting of ten (10) signs delineated on the attached map shall be removed no later than March 18, 2011, provided that the Common Council has authorized payment and the City has vided that the Common Council has authorized payment and the City has remitted such just compensation to the owners of such signs. All such signs may remain in place beyond the above date until said just compensation has been authorized and paid. The owners of such signs shall not increase, add to, alter, or enhance the value of such signs except for routine and required customary. for routine and required customary maintenance. The measure of just compensation for removal of signs under this section shall be as set forth under Section 84.30(7), Wis. Stats. Since the owners of all signs required to be removed under this paragraph are provided a ten (10) year amortization period with just compensation, it is expected that

existing sign leases will not be ex-tended after the effective date of this ordinance beyond the period of pay-
