

Resolution appropriating funds to include the International Business Park to the ecological and trail planning efforts with regard to the La Crosse County Landfill.

AMENDED RESOLUTION

WHEREAS the La Crosse County Landfill is undertaking a large planning effort for the long term use of the landfill that includes ecological and trail planning.

WHEREAS the City of La Crosse has constructed some of the planned trails in the International Business Park, while others remain unconstructed due to questions on wetlands, future connection points, and land ownership issues.

WHEREAS the City of La Crosse Outlots in the business park include “pocket parks” that are difficult to maintain.

WHEREAS the International Business Park is directly adjacent to the County Landfill.

WHEREAS it is to the benefit of the City to have our trail network and outlot management congruent with the efforts going on across the property line in County Landfill.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse that up to \$15,000 be appropriated to add the International Business Park to the Ecological and Trail planning efforts.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the up to \$15,000 is hereby appropriated and ordered paid out of the following:

Industrial Park Sinking Fund	
<u>Tax Incremental District 9 Funds</u>	\$ 15,000

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these expenses are reimbursable by the County Landfill Host Siting Agreement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon reimbursement by the County under the County Landfill Host Siting Agreement, these funds will be returned to the Industrial Park Sinking Fund.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Engineer, Finance Director, and Planning Director are authorized to perform all duties necessary to effectuate this resolution in the best interest of the City.
