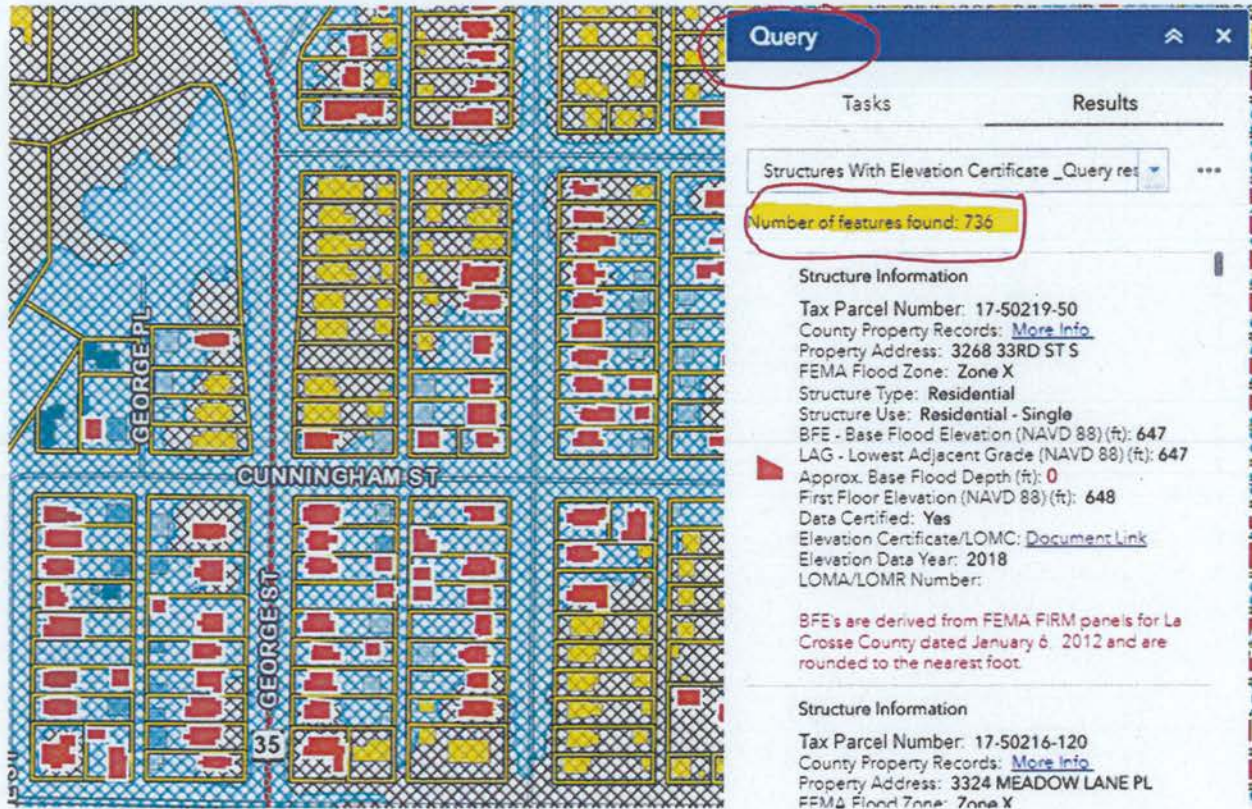


FAC Elevation Certificate Report

January 3rd 2019

- Over the past three years, \$125,000.00 has been appropriated to fund data acquisition in the form of elevation certificates (EC) for structures located in Special flood Hazard Areas in the City of La Crosse.
- \$120,120.00 of that appropriation has been spent on 616 EC's.



- When running the EC query on the City of La Crosse Flood Hazard Map, 736 total EC's are shown. The additional ones were previously on file.
- No additional funding is shown in the 2019 budget for additional EC work. Of the remaining \$70,831.00 left in the Northside Flood Improvements line item, \$68,000.00 is committed to alley construction.
- All certified and uncertified elevation data has been added to the City's GIS mapping and can be used for mitigation planning.
- Additional EC acquisition, if funded, will be in areas with flood depths approaching 3 feet. These areas currently have approximate LIDAR data attached to the structures. This uncertified LIDAR data will be adequate for mitigation planning.
