## NOTICE OF HEARING ON AMENDMENT TO ZONING RESTRICTION

the 3rd Floor Conference Room in City Hall and final action will be determined by the Common Council on Thursday, November 10, 2016 at 7:30 p.m., both in the Council Chambers in the City Hall in the City of La Crosse, La Crosse County, Wisconsin.

Any person interested may be heard for or against such proposed change, and may appear in person, by attorney or may file a formal objection, which objection forms are available in the Office of the City Clerk.

Such proposed change set forth in the ordinance now pending before the Common Council of the City of La Crosse is as follows:

**AN ORDINANCE** to amend Subsection 115-110 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse transferring certain property from the Public/Semi-Public District to the Commercial District.

Address: 618 Tyler St, South Ave and 710 Denton St.

Proposed Use: Healing Garden/Restaurant.

Proposed rezoning is necessary because: In order to compile all parcels into one, the parcels must be the same zoning.
