Resolution appropriating funds for bottled water for Town of Campbell residents negatively impacted by PFAS in drinking water.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Common Council previously appropriated \$15,000 for bottled water service for the Town of Campbell residents negatively impacted by PFAS in their drinking water, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to add additional funds in order to continue to provide bottled water.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council that it hereby appropriates up to the amount of \$25,000 from the Contingency Account (1009909-550000) for bottled water services for Town of Campbell residents negatively impacted by PFAS in drinking water.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED if there is reimbursement by the government for these expenses, the money will be returned to said fund.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Finance/Treasurer and the Mayor of the City of La Crosse are hereby authorized and directed to take all necessary steps to implement this resolution.
