AN ORDINANCE to amend Sub-section 115-110 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse transferring certain property from the Local Business District to the Local Business District requesting amendment to a pre-existing restrictive covenant to add convenience store as a restricted use at 931 16th St. S./1601 Jackson St.
