Resolution appropriating funds in connection with repair to City parking

<u>14-1391</u> 2014 La Crosse Parking Demand Update Final.

The key points of the study were summarized as follows:

- Description of the area studied is identified; consultant did traffic and occupancy counts; looked at current demand Based on current demand there is a deficit of 300 spaces.
- Future zone analysis; divided parking into different zones, had interviews with stakeholders of projects planned or those on the books; i.e. Hampton Hotel, Charmont Hotel, Lot C, etc Projection of future deficit of 1700 spaces within the next five years.
- How do you plan for parking; how big? The consultant did not answer those questions.

Building a parking structure costs about \$18,000 per space. When you phase-in the ramps, the cost is more. A single ramp is not sufficient to provide 1700 more spaces. The Riverside Ramp has approximately 500 spaces, and La Crosse Center ramp has 895 spaces.

Market Square Structural Repairs Update

The estimates for needed repairs amount to \$25,000 for emergency, and \$625,000 for non-emergency. Staff is proceeding with emergency repairs and anticipates a request for bids to be sent out this year, with award of bids in late January, and the work to begin in March. The non-emergency repairs are complicated as to who is responsible.

Report on status of Parking Fees Work Group

Nothing further to report from the sub-group. The Chair recommended deferring further action and discussion on changing parking fees because of ongoing negotiations regarding Lot C development.
