1. That the report of the Board of Public Works pertaining to the La Crosse downtown parking system from September 2018 revenue from the parking system within the proposed assessment district;
2. That a portion of the payment for the costs of operation made by assessing the sum of \$128,978.91 to the property owners in said report;
3. That the benefits shown on the report are true and correct;
4. That the assessments shall be placed in full on the property owners; Assessments not paid when due shall bear interest from February 1, 2020, and may be subject to an assessment lien;
