AMENDED RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, In 2008 the City of La Crosse applied for, and was awarded a Federal Transportation Enhancement (TE) Grant in the amount of \$87,160 which requires a City match of $\frac{$21,709}{$21,790}$ for the preparation of a city-wide bicycle and pedestrian plan, and;

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of La Crosse adopted Resolution 2009-07-057 approving Federal/State/Project Sponsor Transportation Enhancements (TE) Program Project Agreement Project ID: 5991-07-02 entitled City of La Crosse, Bike/Ped Plan between the Wisconsin Department of Transportation and the City of La Crosse for the creation of a bicycle and pedestrian plan for the City of La Crosse subject to monies being provided with amounts as follows:

Federal Share (80%)

\$87,160 (2010 CIP)

City Share (20%)

\$ 21,790 (2010 CDBG Planning Funds. Per the CDBG Administrator this is an annual allocation awarded specifically for planning activities which are determined by the Director of Planning. These funds will be available April 1, 2010.), and;

WHEREAS, the adopted Resolution 2009-07-057 authorized the City Planning Department to prepare and transmit a Request for Proposals (RFP) to consultants with specific expertise in the preparation of bicycle-pedestrian plans, and;

WHEREAS, the City's Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee received four proposals and selected T Y Lin International as the most qualified consultant team primarily for its extensive national experience with Bicycle and Pedestrian Planning.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse that it hereby approves the attached Three-Party Design Engineering Services Contract with T.Y. Lin International, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation, and the City of La Crosse dated August 31, 2011, and releases \$87,160.00 from the 2010-B Promissory Note Fund (Parks) and \$11,164.00 from the 2010 CDBG Planning Funds in an amount not to exceed \$99,329 \$98,324 and further authorizes the Mayor and City Clerk to sign the Three Party Contract.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, City Clerk, Director of Finance, and the Director of Planning and Development are hereby authorized to effectuate this
