

**NOTICE OF HEARING ON
AMENDMENT TO ZONING RESTRICTION**

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Common Council of the City of La Crosse by its Judiciary and Administration Committee will hold a public hearing upon the proposed change in the zoning ordinance hereinafter set forth. Such public hearing will be held at **7:30 p.m. on Tuesday, June 30, 2015** in the Council Chambers in the City Hall in the City of La Crosse, La Crosse County, Wisconsin.

The City Plan Commission of the City of La Crosse will meet to consider such ordinance on **Monday, June 29, 2015 at 4:00 p.m.** in the 3rd Floor Conference Room in City Hall and final action will be determined by the Common Council on **Thursday, July 9, 2015 at 7:30 p.m.**, both in the Council Chambers in the City Hall in the City of La Crosse, La Crosse County, Wisconsin.

Any person interested may be heard for or against such proposed change, and may appear in person, by attorney or may file a formal objection, which objection forms are available in the Office of the City Clerk.

Such proposed change set forth in the ordinance now pending before the Common Council of the City of La Crosse is as follows:

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 115-110 of the Code of Ordinance of the City of La Crosse by transferring certain property from the Multiple Dwelling District to the Public/Semi-Public District – Specific.

Address: 1109 Market Street and 921 Ferry Street.

Proposed Use: Allowing current use of garages for a recycling area and a shop and water source for Washburn Gardens area, parking for MCHS-FH fleet vehicles and green space.

Proposed Rezoning is Necessary Because: Demolition of structures for parking and green space with continued use of garages.

Said property is further described as follows:

17-30056-40. ESPERSON & BURNS ADDITION LOT 4 BLOCK 1.***
