I am writing in regards to the attached documents I received in the mail, postmarked January 18th, 2022.

The document with the La Crosse Fire Department header details "The snow that fell between 12-26-21, and 1-6-22 was removed 1-8-22." According to the chart from weather.gov detailing snow accumulation in the La Crosse area, roughly seven inches of snow fell during this time:

The attached pictures we received from you clearly indicate that efforts had been made within this window of time to keep the sidewalk clear as there is a minimal amount of snow remaining on the sidewalk.
