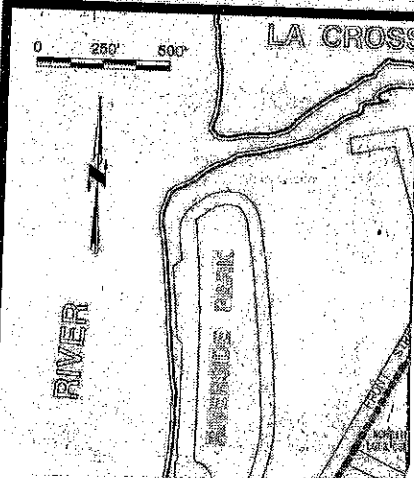

Notice is hereby given that the operating, maintenance, and replacement costs of the Downtown La Crosse Parking System for the operation of the City's parking facilities have been prepared and are now open to inspection in the Parking Utility Office, 1st Floor, City Hall, for the parking system assessment district shown:

Pursuant to Section 66.0703 WI Statutes, the undersigned Board of Public Works of said City hereby gives notice that all persons owning or interested in the real estate outlined on the above map are entitled to examine said costs and assessments, and that on **Monday, July 29, 2019** at 10:00 am, the Board will be in session in the 5th Floor conference room, City Hall, 400 La Crosse Street, to consider any objections that may be filed, and to hear all persons desiring to be heard. Property owners will be able to examine assessments for their property. The assessment rate of \$ 2.05 per \$ 1,000.00 of appraised value remains unchanged from previous years. Actual parking assessments may change if the appraised values of the properties have changed since the last assessment date. The boundaries of the parking assessment district were updated and approved at the regular meeting of the City of La Crosse Common Council held April 11, 2019.

Notice is further given that at 6:00 PM on Thursday, August 1, 2019 the Finance and Personnel Committee of the City Council will hear testimony and consider approval of the 2019-2020 parking assessment. Final Council approval of the assessment rate will occur at a 6:00 meeting on Thursday, August 8, 2019. No public testimony will be heard at the August 8th Council meeting, except by special council vote. The committee and council meetings will be held in the Council Chambers of City Hall, 400 La Crosse Street.
