I/We object for the following reason(s): The owner of this property has a reputation of lending to individuals in the neighborhood who are involved with drugs. We have lived in the Washburn neighborhood since 1998 and have several rental properties here including one across the street from this project (615/617 5th Ave S.) which we purchased in Dec. of 2019 from the owner of the proposed project. It had been a drug house and we had many problems with the plumbing due to the sewer and toilets being clogged with hypodermic needles. My husband is a Mexican immigrant so this is not about race. It is about keeping the Washburn neighborhood on its cleanup track.
