RE: Boathouse Repair Certification Exception for a boathouse on Black River in the City of La Crosse, La Crosse County

Dear Steven Schumacher:

The Department has examined the proposed maintenance and repair of your boathouse, Steve's Boathouse on the Black River located in the NE 1/4, NE 1/4, Section 30, Township 16N, Range 07W, City of La Crosse, La Crosse County.

The proposed work consists of deferred maintenance from the previous owner that needs to be completed. Decking and walkway will be replaced. The roof will be replaced with a metal roof. Siding may be replaced. The spuds (poles) will be replaced. The walls may be replaced or repaired. The windows will be replaced. Some doors will be replaced. Some interior finishes will be replaced or repaired. Skilled professionals will complete the work. When approvals are received the applicant will confer with the company which will install the new spuds to determine the order of construction. No ground disturbance will occur that would require erosion control measures. When needed for demolition and construction waste disposal, a dumpster will be placed on the gravel parking pad. Care will be taken to keep demolition and construction waste out of the waterway. The structure's footprint will not change.

Section 30.121, Wis. Stats., allows an exception to the 50% maintenance and repair limitation for all existing boathouses that were in existence on December 16, 1979. Your boathouse is verified as meeting this exception. Your proposed work must meet the certification exception conditions below and may proceed as planned.

CERTIFICATION CONDITIONS

1. You must notify Sarah Bogen at phone (608) 516-6026 or email sarah.bogen@wisconsin.gov at least 5 days before starting construction and again not more than 5 days after the project is complete.
2. This certification exception **expires 4/16/2029**. If the repairs are not completed by then, you must apply for an extension prior to the expiration date, or a new application for repair certification must be submitted.
3. This approval allows only repairs to the boathouse which are specifically described in your application and does not authorize any other work in the waterway which may require a permit under ss. 30 or 31, Wis. Stats.
4. This certification exception does not authorize any work other than what you specifically describe in your application and plans, and as modified by the conditions of this certification exception. If you wish to alter the project or certification conditions, you must first obtain written approval of the Department.
5. You are responsible for obtaining any permit or approval that may be required for your project by local zoning ordinances or by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers before starting your project.
6. Upon reasonable notice, you shall allow access to your project site during reasonable hours to any Department employee who is investigating the project's construction, operation, maintenance, or certification compliance.
7. The Department may modify or revoke this certification if the project is not completed according to the terms of the certification, or if the Department determines the activity is detrimental to the public interest.
8. You must **post a copy of this certification exception at a conspicuous location** on the project site, visible from the waterway, for at least five days prior to construction, and remaining at least five days after construction. You must also have a copy of the approved plan available at the project site at all times until the project is complete.
9. Your acceptance of this certification exception and efforts to begin work on this project signify that you have **read, understood, and agreed** to follow all conditions of this certification exception.
10. You must submit a series of photographs to the Department, within one week of completion of work on the site. The photographs must be taken from different vantage points and depict all work authorized by this certification.
11. You, your agent, and any involved contractors or consultants may be considered a party to the violation pursuant to s. 30.292, Wis. Stats., for any violations of s. 30, Wis. Stats., or this certification.
12. All repairs and maintenance may not affect the size, location, or configuration of the boathouse.
13. Repair and maintenance may not include any change in roof pitch or addition of decks, walkways, railings, or other architectural features.
14. Decks, walkways, railings, or piers that are permanently attached to the boathouse are part of the boathouse and subject to repair certification.
15. This structure shall be used for the storage of watercraft and associated materials and cannot be converted to allow permanent or temporary human habitation.
16. An exception certification must be obtained each time you wish to make repairs.

17. You must prevent any construction materials from being deposited into any surface waters.
