*Committee is reconsidering this proposal as CIP requests are due soon. Jim Longhurst acknowledged that New York City has used this practice to successfully implement permanent projects. Young suggested this could fit in with priorities in case full project doesn't happen sooner. Hogan asked about potential safety concerns if intersection is not complete. Gallager responded that it was not inherently more dangerous. Fennie commented on high traffic on King St. Staff suggested possibility of including pilot project as an addendum to priorities request in Item #2.*
